<b>Learning Objectives:</b>	Upon completion students will be able to : Use hashtags in twitter for discussion. Set up pin boards and pin content for use in class.			
<b>Face to Face activities:</b>			Learners will set up Twitter and Pintrest accounts. Learners will participate in a synchronous Twitter discussion during the class. Students will also search for and pin content to pin boards.
